| Preparedness | Student is completely prepared and has obviously rehearsed. | Student seems pretty prepared but might have needed a couple more rehearsals. | The student is somewhat prepared, but it is clear that rehearsal was lacking. | Student does not seem at all prepared to present. |
| Time-Limit | Presentation is 9-10 (5-6)minutes long. | Presentation is 8-7(4-5) minutes long. | Presentation 7-6 4(3-4) minutes long. | Presentation is less than 6-5(2-3) minutes OR more than 6(3) minutes. |
| Vocabulary | Uses vocabulary appropriate for the audience. Extends audience vocabulary by defining words that might be new to most of the audience. | Uses vocabulary appropriate for the audience. Includes 1-2 words that might be new to most of the audience, but does not define them. | Uses words or phrases that are not understood by the audience. | Uses several (5 or more) words or phrases that are not understood by the audience. |
| Map | Map turned in with all of the information needed. | Map turned in with most of the information needed. | Map turned in with little information included. | No map turned in. |
| Volume | Volume is loud enough to be heard by all audience members throughout the presentation. | Volume is loud enough to be heard by all audience members at least 90% of the time. | Volume is loud enough to be heard by all audience members at least 80% of the time. | Volume often too soft to be heard by all audience members. |
| Knowledge | The project demonstrates strong knowledge about each destination | The project demonstrates good knowledge of each destination | The project demonstrates average knowledge of each destination. | The project demonstrates weak knowledge of each destination |
| Visual Aids | Visual aids were used very effectively | Visual aids were used adequately. | Visual aids were barely used. | No visual aids were used. |
